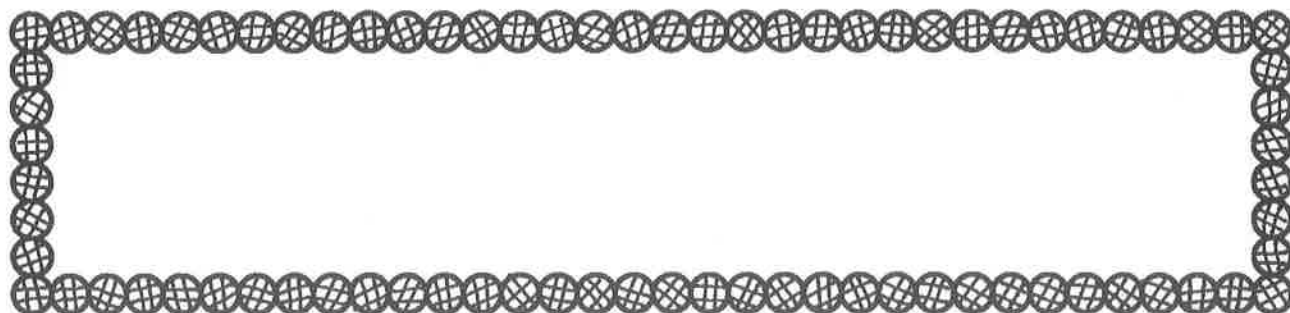

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## Develop ACRONYMS

1. One effective mnemonic device, or memory trick, is to develop an acronym. An acronym is an invented combination of letters. Each letter is a cue to an item you need to remember. For instance, ROY G. BIV stands for the colors red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet. This acronym helps you recall the colors of the visible spectrum.
2. Review your notes from our current unit of study.
3. Then, form an acronym to remember a portion of your notes. Be sure to play around with the order of the letters to create an acronym that is easy to remember.
