- 1. The definition of the pillar
- 2. The image you've collected, and three sentences about how it represents the pillar's values.
- 3. Under each of your other images, 3 sentences about WHY you choose this image for the pillar.

- Your ability to explain WHY the image represents a particular pillar
- The clarity and ability to communicate your understanding of the 4 Pillars
