<b>By</b>	<b>B</b>	<b>Byline</b> (Reporter's Name given in the Prompt)
<b>Deb</b>	<b>D</b>	<b>Dateline</b> *** (Location - the town the event happened in)
<b>Hook</b>	<b>H</b>	<b>Hook</b> (Attention Grabber)
<b>On</b>	<b>O</b>	<b>On ...</b> (On Wednesday, April 10, 2013...)
<b><u>Thursday</u></b>	<b>T</b>	<b><u>The Purpose</u></b> (of the presentation/field trip/fund raiser/ etc.)
